

COMPLIANCE CHECKS IN LINN COUNTY

On September 30, the Linn County Sheriff's Office conducted an alcohol compliance check with some of the convenience and grocery stores in Linn County. An alcohol compliance check is when an underage age person is sent into the business to try purchasing alcohol using their own driver's license. In Linn County the underage person was accompanied by a Linn County Sheriff Deputy. Out of 24 businesses that were checked, 18 passed the check and did not sell alcohol to the underage person. The following is a list of all the businesses that passed the alcohol compliance check. (Not all businesses in each community were checked yet so just because their name is not on this list, does not mean that they failed the check. The Sheriff's office may not have had time yet to reach that business.) The Linn County underage drinking prevention coalitions would like to recognize Casey's General Stores in Walker, Center Point, Springville, Lisbon, and in Ely, Lefty's Convenience Store in Alburnett, Center Point Foods, Center Point Travel, The Corner Store in Center Point, Pantry Express in Robins, Walford BP, Troy Store in Troy Mills, Main Street Market in Coggon, Sherbon's Market in Walker, Skip's in Prairieburg and R & R One Stop in Central City. Congratulations to these businesses and their employees for being diligent to check identification in order to help keep kids safe.
